*Fall at Valley Folk Music*

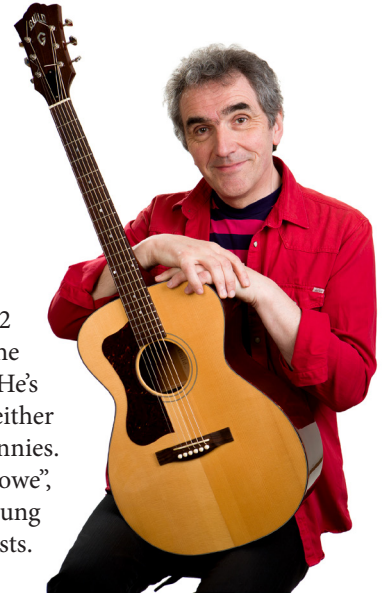
## Jez Lowe

Jez Lowe has leapt into his third decade as a song-writing troubadour from England, on the back of a new and much acclaimed album—his nineteenth—entitled *The Ballad Beyond*. He's long been one of the UK's busiest folk performers, playing for audiences the world over, either solo, (with guitar, cittern and harmonica accompaniment), or with his band *The Bad Pennies*.
